These include enhanced cleaning where we have focused on reducing or removing items which may carry the virus and extending the time allocated to cleaning each caravan.

Your arrival

• Please stay at home if you are ill. If you become ill during your stay please return home immediately and advise us by email or text 07814 539857.

• To allow extra time for cleaning the check-in time is now from 5pm. Please let us know if you expect to arrive after 6.30pm.

• On arrival please stay in your car at reception and someone will find you and lead you to your caravan. If we are not with you within five minutes please call 01568 750665.

In your caravan

• The beds are made up depending on the size of your party – for two people the double bed only, for three people the double bed and one single and for four people the double bed and two singles. If you require more beds to be made up please let us know in advance.

• You should bring towels and tea towels, oven gloves, toilet rolls, washing up and cleaning equipment, hand sanitiser, disinfectant etc. Please make sure that everything is taken from the caravan when you leave.

• We have withdrawn some items of equipment to minimise the cleaning at each changeover, and all tourist leaflets and our welcome book. Welcome information is available online at <u>www.wigleyorchard.co.uk</u> or <u>www.stmichaelscaravans.co.uk</u>.

• Instructions for the TV and for accessing Wifi are in the caravan.

• Please do not invite visitors into your caravan and do not gather in a social group.

• Please do not allow children to roam unsupervised around the park.

• Please limit the number of visits you make to the park waste and recycling compound.

• Please remember to wash your hands frequently. A hand sanitiser dispenser is sited at reception.

• Maintain a safe space – 2 metres apart is better than 1 metre. Please maintain this space if you have any interaction with other guests or with our staff.

• If you need any help during your stay please email <u>tenburycaravans@icloud.com</u> or text 07814 539857. Our staff will not be able to come into the caravan while you are in it.

Departure

• Remove everything you have brought with you and make sure no food is left in the caravan.

• Leave caravan windows and doors open for good ventilation (ajar on catches if wet).

• Leave the key in the key box at reception

• Email us immediately on <u>tenburycaravans@icloud.com</u> to confirm your departure and that no-one in your party has been ill.

In the community

Please be aware that some members of our local community may not welcome visitors so please maintain safe spaces, particularly in shops and car parks, on footpaths and anywhere you have contact with other people.

Track and trace
