Drain down your caravan for winter

We've written to you separately about your winter drain down. We don't mind you dealing with it independently, but please don't forget to have it done. Beware of Jack Frost – he will bite!

Gas Safe

Gas Safe checks are best done in the spring so we'll write to you about these early in 2019.

Treatment of decks

We don't recommend applying stain or paint onto the treated timber we use for decks. If you're concerned about it fading in the sunlight we suggest using deck oil.

If you do decide to colour your deck, please consult with us first. We will usually agree but we wouldn't want some garish bright Lawrence Lewellyn Bowen deck to appear on either park.
